





Meaning of cultural awarenes and intercultural competence.





"The crisis and conflict scenarios of the future will place high demand on social and intercultural competence. The leadership, training and education of soldiers must be adapted accordingly."



Intercultural competence – the ability to deal with people from a different cultural background – increases the confidenc of soldiers and promote the acceptance of minorities. On poerations abroad, intercultural commpetence is also an essential prerequisite für mission accomplishment and self-protection.

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

Five dimensions for analysing a "culture"



Physical dimension: (arable) land, mountains, potable water, rivers, the environment, mineral resources.

Economic dimension: produce, trade, ways of dealing with scarcity, but also aspects like entrepreneurial confidence and black market.

Social dimension: the way any society defines and organizes its relationships: young vs. old; have vs. have-nots; male vs. female.

Political dimension: how a society has divided its power and organized its leadership.

Identity dimension: with joint beliefs and history that helped to shape the identity of a culture/society.




A Definition of culture

Culture could be understood as a handed-down, group-oriented, internalised system of orientation that influences, primarily on a subconscious level, our entire being, thoughts, emotions, beliefs, actions and social interaction.


Cultural overlapping situation




Orientation system Culture "A"




